Citizen Awards

The aim of the Citizen awards is to recognise outstanding contributions to the local community. The following guidelines are to assist you in the selection process.

1. Citizen Award is for a person 28 years or older on the 26th January, 2019.
2. Young Citizen Award is for a person aged between 16 & 28 on the 26th January 2019.
3. All persons who, through their contributions being completed on a voluntary basis or exceeding the normal requirements of the nominee's paid work have benefited the local community.
4. Winners of the Citizen and Young Citizen Awards will become the Carpentaria Shire Ambassadors until 26 January 2019.

Community Event of the Year

The Award is given in recognition of hosting a special event during 2019.

Sports Awards

The aim of these Awards is to recognise outstanding achievements in, or contributions to, the field of Sport.

1. One award shall be granted to a participant aged 18 years or over as at 26th January 2019, who has a noteworthy record of achievement in Sport.

2. One award shall be granted to a participant aged under 18 years as at 26th January 2019, who has a noteworthy record of achievement in Sport.
3. One award shall be granted to a person of any age who has made a significant contribution to Sport as a Coach, Official and/or Administrator. The nominee's contributions will have been completed on a voluntary basis or exceeding the normal requirements of their paid work.
4. All recognised Sports will be considered.
5. Junior Sports Person of the Year winner will be nominated by Council for the North Queensland Sports Development Bursaries in 2019.
6. Junior Sports Person, Senior Sports Person and Sports Administrator **IN THE CARPENTARIA SHIRE** will be nominated by the Australia Day Council Committee for nomination in the North Queensland Sports Foundation 2019 Sports Star Awards.

Junior Sports and Arts/ Cultural Awards eligibility requirements are that the person must be less than 18 years of age on 26th January 2019. To be eligible all nominees must be Australian Citizens and reside within the Carpentaria Shire. (Junior residents that attend Boarding School or other further education outside of the Carpentaria Shire are still eligible).

Arts/ Cultural Awards

The aim of this award is to recognise individuals/ organisation that have produced/ promoted or taught in arts and culture. Examples of this may include but are not limited to, painting, music, performers, visual, cultural awareness, sculptures, photography.

Rural Citizen of the Year

The aim of this award is to recognise outstanding achievements by an individual partnership or group, or contribution to, the rural community in Carpentaria Shire. Nominees must reside within Carpentaria Shire.

1. This award is open to citizens involved in primary industries and natural resource management.
2. One award shall be granted to an individual, partnership or group of Carpentaria Shire.
3. The award is an open-age category. Nominees can be under 18 years of age.

Committee of the Year

This Award is designed to acknowledge committees who, through their efforts, have given something to the community. This may include but is not limited to event organisation and fundraisers or other contributions to the community. It is one way in which various community groups, and committees can be officially recognised for the contribution they make to the whole community. The committee must be of not for profit status.

Volunteer of the Year

This Award is designed to acknowledge those who, through their efforts, have given something to the

community. This may include but is not limited to fundraisers, regular donations or other contributions to the community. It is one way in which a volunteer can be officially recognised for the contribution they make to the whole community.

The Mayor's Award

This Award is designed to acknowledge the quiet achievers of Carpentaria Shire who have shown ambition, self-motivation and dedication by pursuing different opportunities for themselves and/or others in the community. The recipient of this award openly and proudly represents the Carpentaria Shire in the field they are pursuing. Recipients must be 18 years and over.
