## Accommodation providers\*

Hostels

Appropriate record keeping includes a

- Boarding houses
- Bed and breakfasts
- Caravan and camping parks
- Backpackers
- Accommodation with shared bathrooms or kitchen

Accommodation providers must have and implement a health management plan, including appropriate record keeping.

record of a guest's locations visited and residence details for the 14 days prior to accessing the accommodation service.

If a guest has been overseas in the last 14 days, they must provide evidence of self-quarantine.

If a guest has been in a **COVID-19 hotspot** in the last 14 days, they must provide evidence of **self-quarantine**. Facilities should manage guests to allow access to areas on the basis of 1 person per 4 square metres.

Accommodation providers can also manage guests' access to areas using a 'household unit' method, where the 'household unit' comprises of no more than 4 guests, and access to communal areas is on a rostered basis.

Hygiene and cleaning requirements in accordance with health directions and recommendations.

\*unless the facility operates solely for permanent

residents, or health and community services.

Transport providers

**Transport providers** of private workforce transportation services to agribusinesses, agribusiness labour hire companies and seasonal worker accommodation providers

Transport providers must have and implement a health management plan, including appropriate record keeping.

Details of workers using the transport service each day must be recorded, including accommodation and workplace information.
