The RADF Program is a highly successful state and local government partnership supporting professional artists and arts practitioners living in regional Queensland.

It focuses on the development of quality art and arts practice for, and with, regional communities.

Over the years in Carpentaria Shire, RADF has funded a wide range of workshops including – Photography, writing workshops, history displays, touring productions, pottery, silver smithing, paper tole, community mosaic project, quilting and glass work. These workshops ranged from beginners through to advanced classes.

Arts Queensland manages the RADF Program by means of an annual budget for allocations to individual councils. Each council has a nominated RADF Liaison Officer and a RADF Committee that is culturally and geographically representative of the community. The role of the RADF Committee is to assess applications and make recommendations to Council as to whether these are funded or not.
